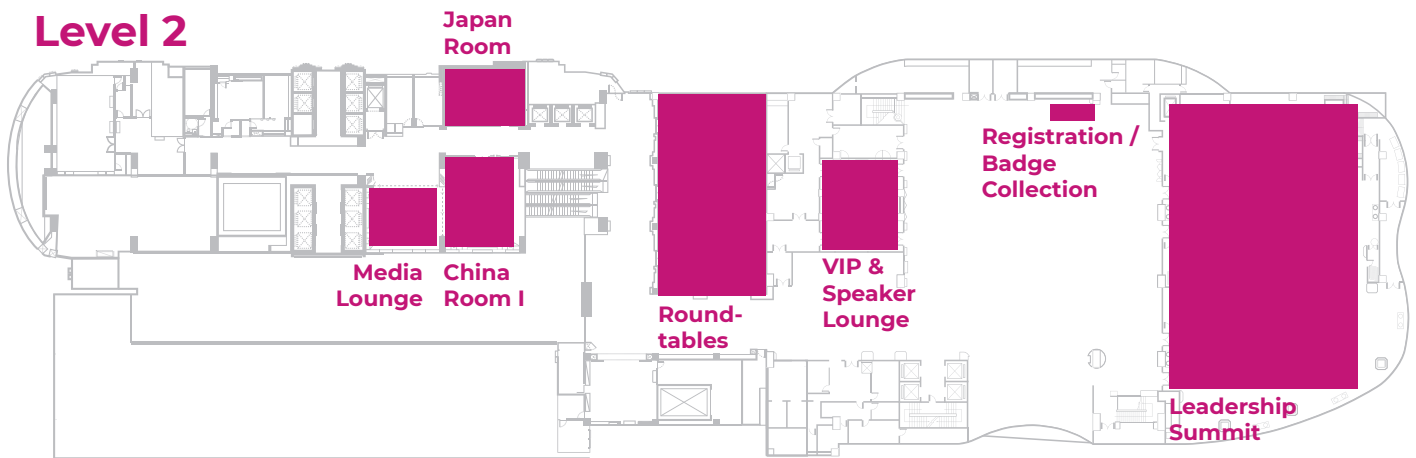

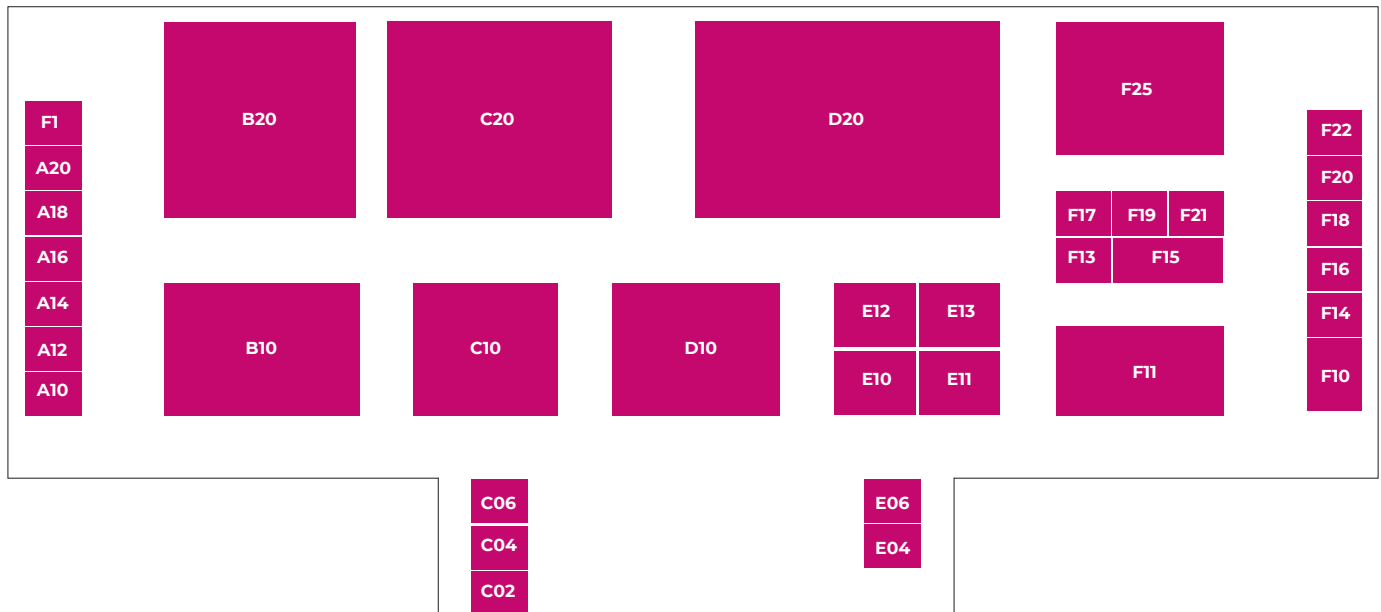

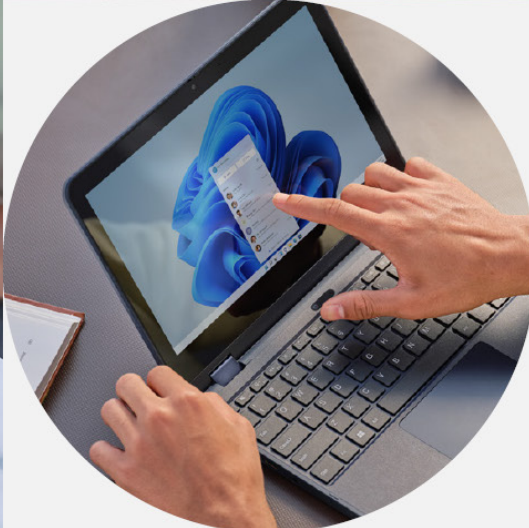

If this is your first time visiting Thailand, we've compiled some useful information to help you get familiar.



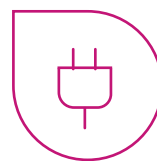
### Time

Thailand's currency is the Thai Baht (THB). Denominations include 20, 50, 100, 500, and 1,000 in notes.



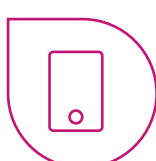
### Electricity

Experience the elegance of **Wat Phra Chetuphon Wimonmungklaram** or **Wat Pho**, one of Thailand's oldest temples. Wat Pho hosts 99 pagodas, the highest number in Thailand, and the largest collection of Buddha images. Visitors can pay respect to the beautiful reclining Buddha which is the 3rd largest in Thailand at 46m long!



Visit the exquisite **Wat Phra Kaew (Kaew)** to see the Emerald Buddha, Thailand's most sacred icon, and explore the Grand Palace, the official residence of the Kings of Siam and Thailand. This a must-visit visit for tourists in Bangkok.
